

Corvus Markets Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how Corvus Markets ("Corvus Markets", "we", "us" or "our") collects, uses, stores, and protects personal data. We are committed to processing personal data lawfully, fairly, and transparently in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the Data Protection Act 2018, and relevant Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) expectations.

2. Data Controller

Corvus Markets acts as a data controller in respect of personal data processed in connection with our services, including acting as an introducing broker where applicable.

3. Scope of This Policy

This policy applies to individuals whose personal data we process, including website visitors, corporate clients, prospective clients, counterparties, professional contacts, and representatives of regulated or unregulated entities.

4. Categories of Personal Data

We may process personal data including identification details, contact information, professional and corporate details, transactional and relationship information, communications, and regulatory or compliance-related data where required.

5. Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal data only where a lawful basis applies, including performance of a contract, compliance with legal or regulatory obligations, consent (where required), and our legitimate interests in operating a regulated financial services business, provided those interests are not overridden by data subject rights.

6. Purposes of Processing

Personal data is processed to facilitate introductions, onboarding, due diligence, compliance with FCA rules, prevention of financial crime, relationship management, and the operation of our business in a lawful and proportionate manner.

7. Data Sharing and Disclosures

We may disclose personal data to regulated counterparties, service providers, professional advisers, regulators, and law enforcement authorities where required or permitted by law. Data sharing is limited to what is necessary and subject to appropriate safeguards.

8. International Transfers

Where personal data is transferred outside the United Kingdom, we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place, including adequacy decisions, standard contractual clauses, or equivalent measures.

9. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, including statutory retention periods applicable to regulated financial services firms.

10. Data Subject Rights

Individuals have rights under UK GDPR, including the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict, or object to processing, and the right to data portability. Requests will be handled in accordance with statutory timeframes.

11. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss, destruction, or disclosure, consistent with regulatory expectations.

12. Complaints

If you have concerns regarding our handling of personal data, you may contact us directly. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
